1.1 Increase community engagement and inclusivity

- i. Promote diversity and inclusion for residents and newcomers through accommodating, inclusive services and public spaces, that are universally accessible to citizens, fostering connections and vibrant communities
- ii. Enhance citizen engagement and participation in identifying public service improvements to bring about greater transparency, accountability and social inclusion, resulting in tangible improvements to people's lives
- iii. Implement a comprehensive customer service strategy and develop strategies for improving civic life and engagement with the Town of Lincoln



1.2 Become a talent magnet

- i. Continue to attract and retain the best talent to the broader Lincoln community, through advocacy in partnerships with private sector businesses and industry associations, to address shortages of skilled labour
- ii. Invest in Town staff training and development to ensure business continuity



1.3 Promote open and transparent governance

 Leverage current technology to make the Town's services, programs and initiatives more user-friendly and accessible to better engage the community



1.4 Invest in social infrastructure

- Optimize the existing parks network to ensure residents have access to nature, promoting healthy and active lifestyles
- ii. Continue to promote cultural and community initiatives through public facilities and open spaces
- iii. Explore and develop strategies for creating multi-purpose community gathering places and hubs through public-private partnerships



1.5 Increase connectivity through transportation network

- Collaborate with regional partners to expand affordable and accessible transit options including development of a GO Train Station and mobility hub
- ii. Invest in key transportation projects and collaborate with Niagara Region to ensure seamless travel through Lincoln
- iii. Implement active transportation plan to increase non-motorized options to get around, including walkability, cycling and trails

- Improve the availability of retail offerings to keep local dollars and economic output in Lincoln
- iii. Develop strategy focusing on vibrant downtowns such as implementing additional BIA models across the community and completing community improvement designs (including Jordan Village and Vineland Central Business Districts [CBD] Design)



2.3 Cultivate agricultural excellence through support for innovation


- Develop a strategy that further supports agriculture in Lincoln, through economic opportunities to drive diversity through both traditional and value-added agriculture
- Expand programs with community partners to support and educate on agricultural innovation and irrigation as economic drivers



2.4 Become a top tourist destination

- Increase visitors to the community and attract additional tourism-related businesses that create new jobs and help foster economic growth
- ii. Develop and implement a Destination Marketing Organization (DMO) in collaboration with both public and private sector partners to market Lincoln and surrounding areas as a premier tourist destination
- iii. Take on a more strategic role in managing the destination while overseeing work of the DMO in promoting the Niagara Benchlands to a variety of target markets

3.1 Promote a healthy & safe community

- Continue to promote public safety and preparedness through education, prevention and partnerships, while maintaining standards for fire safety, emergency response and cybersecurity
- ii. Continue to develop and implement road safety initiatives such as speed reduction, traffic calming and joint truck traffic safety blitzes and enforcement initiatives



3.2 Champion environmental stewardship, heritage and smart growth

- i. Foster responsible community and environmental stewardship through the implementation of a Climate Adaption Plan for improving climate resilience and addressing climate-related risks
- ii. Continue to build public awareness and understanding of our shared responsibility to conserve and protect the environment
- iii. Improve air quality and remove carbon from the atmosphere through growing the urban tree canopy, and further establishing policies that address tree protection, planting and property standard requirements
- iv. Promote green and low environmental impact development strategies

- Create an irrigation strategy in partnership with other municipalities within the Niagara Region
- vi. Review the Town's heritage processes to improve the protection and enhancement of heritage assets



3.3 Sustainable financial management

- Utilize the Town's Asset Management Plan and other strategies as key decision-making tools to address long-term planning of projects and infrastructure needs
- ii. Continue to conduct long-term financial forecasting, debt modelling and long-term borrowing, to ensure the viability of the future tax base
- iii. Leverage municipally owned properties as both community assets through re-purposing and sources of revenue through sales opportunities

- i. Strengthen advocacy for Town issues on the Provincial and Federal government agendas in order to receive grants to fund key community projects, thus minimizing burden on the local taxpayer
- ii. Participate in provincial, national and international organizations, work with business and community leaders to develop support for Town strategies and intergovernmental initiatives that translate to funding for the Town and local businesses, thus growing the local economy
- iii. Continue to explore and implement shared service models in collaboration with other local municipalities to seek efficiencies and excellence in service delivery



3.5 Balanced and diversified housing options

- i. Respond and adhere to changes to provincial policy to ensure adequate housing stock in Lincoln, while promoting diversified housing options to meet the current economic landscape, changing needs of families and households, and the aging population
- ii. Continue government relations and advocacy with the not-for-profit sector and senior levels of government to identify partnerships, policy and incentive programs that prioritize housing opportunities for all residents, in collaboration with Lincoln's Housing Select Committee
