Aberdeen Road and Hillside Drive Road Reconstruction

PROJECT LOCATION:

Aberdeen Road (King Street to Hillside Drive) & Hillside Drive (Aberdeen Road to Ashby Drive)

PROJECT BACKGROUND

Aberdeen Road and Hillside Drive are rural boundary roads in Beamsville that have experienced increased traffic over the past several years as the community has grown. Increased levels of active transportation alongside deteriorating road conditions and increased vehicle volumes have triggered the need for comprehensive upgrades along these corridors. Our aim is to not only rebuild the roadways, but to enhance them to ensure optimal safety and functionality for all users, both now and in the foreseeable future.

PROJECT UPDATE

Hydro One's scheduled work, originally slated for April 23, has been rescheduled again to the end of May. Following its completion, the other utility work will follow.

WHAT TO EXPECT NEXT

Walkers Construction Limited is tentatively scheduled to mobilize to site in mid to late May.

Residents will be contacted by a dBA representative to schedule a precondition survey to identify all existing signs of interior and exterior damage before construction begins. This information is used to determine the extent of contractor responsibility in the unlikely event that damage occurs during construction.

A precondition survey can protect the property/business owner and the contractor of the site where construction activities will take place.

Please note, to protect your privacy, the information gathered stays with the third party and the contractor, and the Town of Lincoln does not have access to any information unless a claim is filed.

Signs and traffic cones will be placed before construction begins. Additionally, you can follow the project by visiting the

- replacement of culverts
- new road surface with paved shoulders along Aberdeen from King to Hillside and Hillside from Aberdeen to Ashby
- speed humps
- line painting
- grading
- new fire hydrants
- new street lights
- new guiderail
