

# Third Party Advertisers FAQs

**Q: How do I file a notice of registration to become a third party advertiser?**

A: To become a third party advertiser, you must file a completed notice of registration (Form 7) in person at Town Hall in the Clerks department as original signatures are required. Appointments can be scheduled by contacting the Town Clerk's office either by email [election@lincoln.ca](mailto:election@lincoln.ca) or by phone 905-563-2799 ext. 513.

**Q: Who is eligible to register?**

A: You are eligible to register as a third party advertiser if you are:

- An individual who is normally a resident of Ontario
- A corporation that carries on business in Ontario
- A trade union that holds bargaining rights for employees in Ontario

**Q: Who is not eligible to register as a third party advertiser?**

- A candidate whose nomination has been filed under section 33 of the [Municipal Elections Act, 1996](#)
- A federal political party registered under the Canada Elections Act (Canada) or any federal constituency association or registered candidate at a federal election endorsed by that political party
- A provincial political party, constituency association, registered candidate or leadership contestant registered under the [Elections Finances Act, 1990](#)
- The Crown in right of Canada or Ontario, a municipality or local board
